RECOMMENDATION

On July 17, 2007, the School Board of Brevard County (School Board) voted to deny the charter application of The City of Palm Bay, Palm Bay High School (Charter School). The School Board's letter of denial was dated July 27, 2007. The Charter applicant filed this appeal on August 27, 2007. On November 16, 2007, the Charter School Appeal Commission heard the appeal of this matter. **Thereafter, the Commission voted 5 to 0 to recommend to the State Board of Education to grant the appeal of the Charter School.** The Commission's justifications for its recommendation were as follows:

1. The Commission voted 5 to 0 that the School Board did not have competent, substantial evidence to support its finding that the Application was statutorily deficient in the area of "Curriculum Plan."
2. The Commission voted 5 to 0 that the School Board did not have competent, substantial evidence to support its finding that the School was statutorily deficient in the area of "Reading Curriculum."
3. The Commission voted 5 to 0 that the School Board did not have competent substantial evidence to support its finding that the School was statutorily deficient in the area "Financial Plan."
4. The Commission voted 5 to 0 that the School Board did deny the Applicant due process in the evaluation process of the Application.
5. The Commission voted 5 to 0 that the School Board's denial of due process in the evaluation process was not harmless error.
